

Local Rules

B-3 Provisional Ball for Ball in a Penalty Area

If a player does not know whether his or her ball is in the penalty area, the player may play a provisional ball under Rule 18.3.

E-1 Dropping Zones

Drop zones are an additional relief for a ball in a penalty area on holes 4,8,10,14,16 and 18.

F-1 Defining Abnormal Course Conditions and Integral Objects

The gravel roads left of #9 and #15 are deemed to be integral objects.

F-5 Immovable Obstructions Close to Putting Greens

On the line of play, and is:

Within two club-lengths of the putting green, and

Within two club-lengths of the ball.

F-7 Relief from Seams of Cut Turf

If a player's ball lies in or touches a seam of cut turf or a seam interferes with the player's area of intended swing:

Ball in General Area. The player may take relief under Rule 16.1b.

F-18 Treating Movable Objects to Be Immovable

All split rail fencing on the course are treated as immovable obstructions from which free relief is allowed under Rule 16.1. Relief is not allowed to be taken under Rule 15.2

F-23 Temporary Immovable Obstructions

Relief from a TIO is normally allowed when there is physical interference or line of sight interference from the TIO.

All fans are Temporary Immovable Obstructions.

Hole #5: The area within the red penalty area defined by red stakes w/ a green stripe left of the fairway on Hole 5, is a no play zone. When a ball is in the no play zone within the penalty area, the ball must not be played as it lies and relief must be taken from interference by the no play zone under Rule 17.1E. As an additional option to relief, a drop zone as been placed on the Red tee box.
